In May next year, the ORTV truck that has been serving with us throughout rain or shine will be 10 year old and we need to replace it with another one to help us transport equipments (props, audio equipments, and musical instruments, etc.) for our evangelistic meetings. Due to high Car Ownership Certificate (COE) fee, changing of vehicle is a heavy burden for us. The estimated preliminary cost for it is about S\$90,000. Therefore, we need your prayers and supports.
